1) Make your own Arthur's Hat!

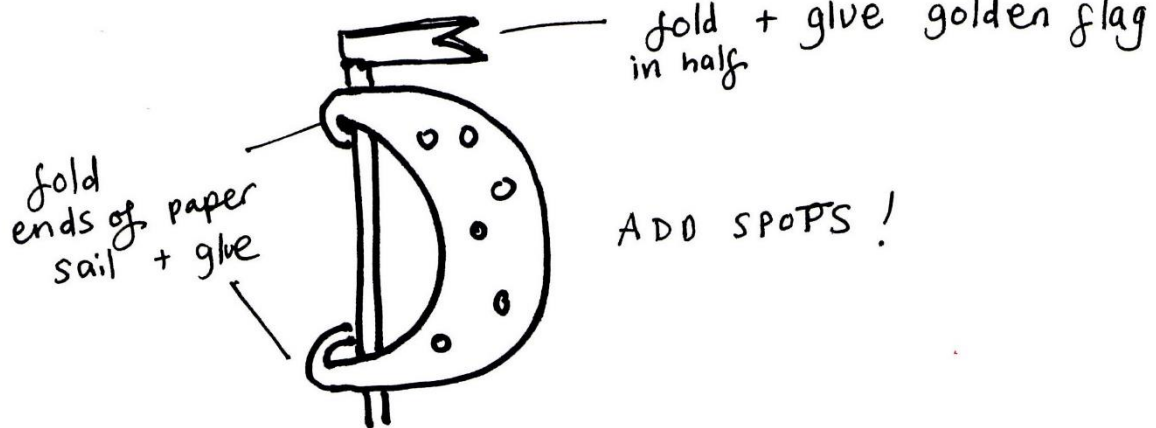
Each Kid needs

- sail (Paper)
- straw
- line of spots
- golden flag (Old tub or box)
- boat hat
- grape size of playdough (make sure enough before sharing out!).

On each table

- PVA glue
- pens / pencils
- tissue paper
- plain paper

① ASSEMBLE MAST / SAIL



② ATTACH MAST TO BOAT HAT

Glue lump of playdough in middle bottom boat + stick straw in.

③ DECORATE with tissue paper which can be ripped - use one or as many colours as you like

④ ADD FAMILY / FRIENDS / PETS

Draw people / animals on plain paper + stick inside



⑤ WEAR + DANCE AS IF SAILING ON SEA!

2) Puppets!

Make your own Arthur puppet!

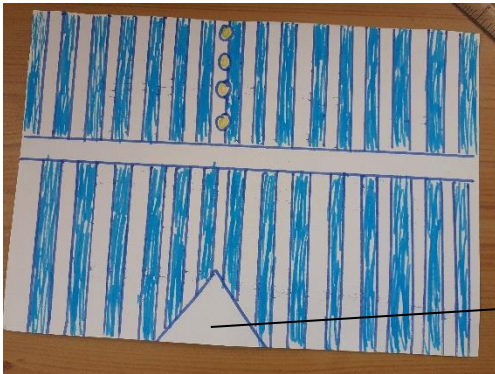
You will need:

- Some card or loo roll tube
- Colouring in pens
- Pipe cleaner (if you have it! If you don't find something else)
- Wool or string
- Googly Eyes (optional)
- Scissors
- Glue/Sellotape



Step One

On an A5 piece of card or loo roll tube, design Arthur's pyjamas!



If you want to, you can cut a triangle out of the bottom for Arthur's pyjama trousers!

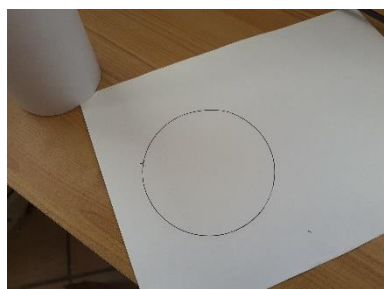
Step Two

Roll the card round and stick it with sellotape or glue.



Step Three

Draw around the edge of a cup to create a big circle, this will be Arthur's head. Once you've drawn the circle, cut it out and draw Arthur's face and add your wool or string to his face for his hair! And then stick it on the body!



Step Four

Sellotape your pipe cleaner (or alternative) to the body of Arthur to make his arms!



Step Five

Place your Arthur puppet on your hand and play!
