



# Make a Window Display



## You will need:

Tracing paper/greaseproof paper  
Tissue paper  
Black card or paper  
Scissors,  
Glue stick  
Strong sticky tape  
A ruler or measuring tape  
(Optional) Sharpie pens or felt tips

1

Measure your window (choose one that people will be able to admire when they walk past)

2

Create your design. Think about the themes of 'community' and 'being thankful' to help inspire you! We recommend drawing your masterpiece on paper before you start crafting and cutting.

3

Measure, cut and stick your tracing paper together so that it is the size of your window

4



Cut out shapes/images from tissue paper and black card, and stick to the side of the tracing paper that will be facing your window.

5



Stick your masterpiece to your window! Make sure you get it as close to the window as possible, using sticky tape to secure it

6

Wait until it gets dark then light your window up.

You can use table lamps to back light your window for extra effect.

Don't forget to leave your curtains open so that your design is well lit!
