








3) Can you colour this COSMONAUT in?





4) Make a moon!





You will need:

- A paper plate
- A piece of tin foil
- Yellow card
- Some string
- 1) Wrap your paper plate in tin foil
- 2) Draw three stars on the yellow card and cut them out
- 3) Use a hole punch to put three holes in the bottom of the moon and one hole in the top of the moon
- 4) Cut three pieces of string (between 8 12cm)
- 5) Tie each piece of string through one hole in the bottom and then tie a star to the other end of the bottom
- 6) Cut a longer piece of string to tie from the top hole
- 7) Find a nice place in your home to hang it!
