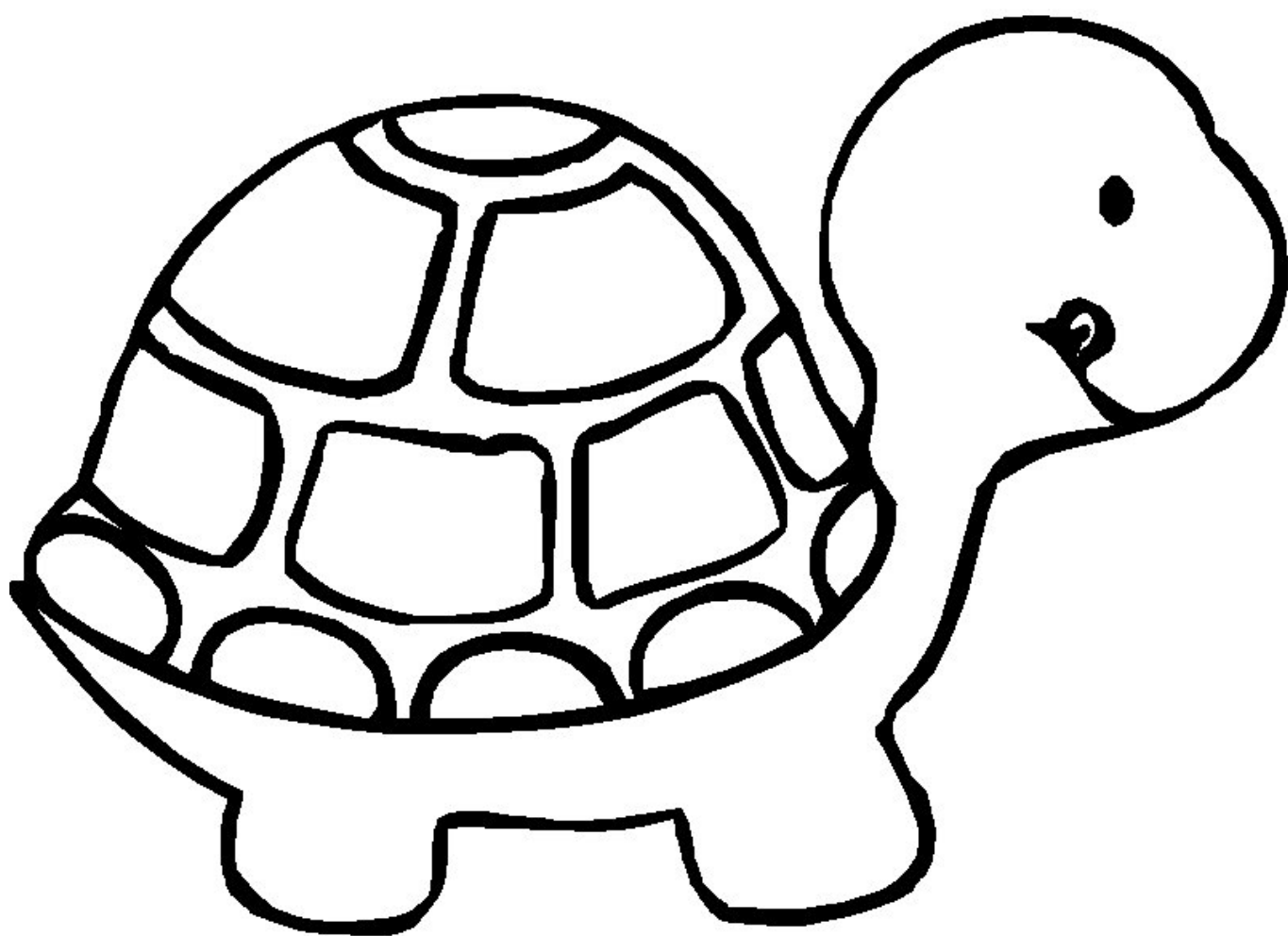

Make your own fish puppet!

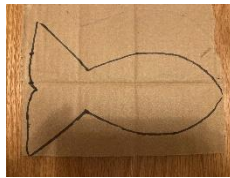
What you will need

- Some cardboard
- A fish template
- Glue
- Masking tape
- Pens
- Bamboo skewers or straws



Step One (1)

Put the fish template on your cardboard and draw around it. Make sure that the grain of the cardboard is going from the top of your fish to the bottom (vertical). Once you are happy, cut it out.



Step Two (2)

Get about 50cm of masking tape and scrunch it up in a ball to make an eye. You might want to get a small piece of masking tape to go over it to make it smooth. Draw a pupil in the middle and glue it to your puppet.



Step Three (3)

Decorate your fish!



Step Four (4)

Attach your straws or skewers to the back of the fish, or skewers can be gently inserted into the middle of the card.

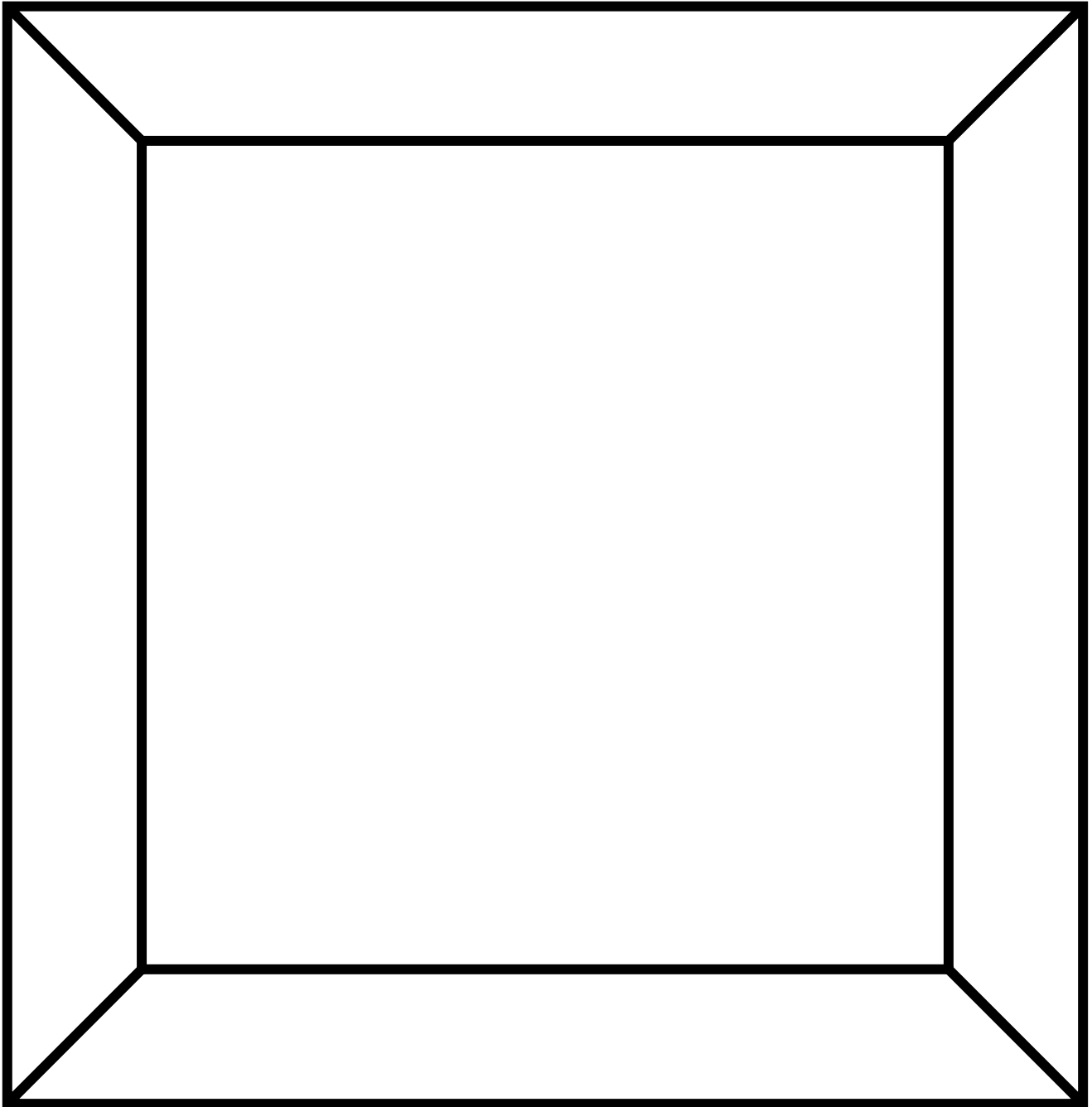


Ta da! Have fun with your fish puppet!
